This year marks our 5th anniversary—a significant milestone of God's faithfulness—and we couldn't have done it without your prayers, generosity, and unwavering support.



Let me take you through the highlights of this extraordinary year, as we celebrate the work accomplished and look forward to what lies ahead.



A YEAR IN REVIEW: HIGHLIGHTS FROM 2024

1. Ministry Growth and Outreach

This year, the Lord has blessed us to serve in numerous ways:

EVANGELISM AND TRANSFORMATION:

- Distributed 50 Bibles, some leading recipients to Christ.
- Led 40 boda (motorbike) riders to salvation through targeted outreach.
- Witnessed a remarkable transformation as a lady working in our garden turned away from witchcraft and accepted Jesus.

CHARITY AND EMPOWERMENT:

- Provided Christmas meals to over 300 patients in a local hospital (Dec. 20–23).
- Supplied a solar panel to a 90-year-old woman, providing light and comfort in her home.
- Hosted Mpox sensitization sessions, led by Madam Luyiga Justine, to educate our community on preventive measures.

2. Visitors and Supporters

- **The Santiago Family from the USA:** In January, they blessed us with school supplies, inspiring us with their generosity.
- **The Bwanika Family from Kampala:** In August, my siblings visited and supported Leilani Kindergarten with 45 pairs of shoes and school supplies.



ACCOMPLISHMENTS IN MINISTRY GOALS

As we celebrate five years, we remain steadfast in our long-term goals:

GOAL ACHIEVEMENTS:



- Fed over 1500 families in need over the past five years.
- Constructed a dormitory to house vulnerable children, which later evolved into the establishment of Leilani Kindergarten.
- Progressed in our vision of sharing the Gospel with over 2500 people by end of 2025.

FUTURE GOALS:

- Expand MWACM's reach to countries like Kenya, Ghana, and South Africa.
- Build a hospital to serve children and pregnant mothers across Africa.



3. Leilani Kindergarten



ACHIEVEMENTS

Our school continues to grow as a center of hope and education:

- Enrollment Growth: 65 students enrolled and nurtured by our hardworking team of 6 staff members.



INFRASTRUCTURE DEVELOPMENT:



- Constructed two classrooms, each accommodating 60 students, and added a Primary One class.
- Began processing the Kindergarten's registration license, a critical step toward official recognition.
- Employed an architect to draft 3D schematics for our newly constructed building, paving the way for future development.





4. Sustainability and Agriculture

- Our female goat gave birth to three kids, multiplying resources for milk and income generation.
- A bountiful maize harvest from our gardens has provided food security and additional resources for ministry operations.



Every Friday, we hold a prayer session at Leilani, where children engage in Bible study, share stories, and grow in discipleship. Health and well-being: Provided measles immunizations to all our children, ensuring their safety and health.

Launched the process of building our official website, which will enhance our communication and outreach.

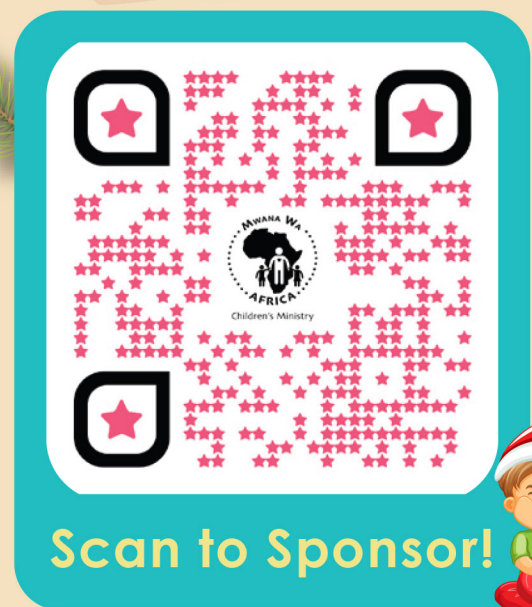
